- There are 31 branches and more than 50,000 members
- Chinese chemists knew IUPAC very well
 - **→ IUPAC** is a largest and highest level international organization in Chemistry
 - → IUPAC arranged many conferences and other activities in China
- IUPAC should do more for publicizing the Chemistry in developing countries and underdeveloped regions
 - → Have more developing countries join IUPAC
 - Arrange more conferences, seminar or training courses in developing countries
